WHO WE ARE

The Chamber of Shipping of America (CSA) represents U.S. based companies that own, operate or charter oceangoing tank, container, or dry bulk vessels engaged in the domestic and/or international trades. Current members include companies that own, operate or charter U.S. flag or non-US flag vessels.

CSA is active in representing its members before the U.S. Congress and administrative agencies such as the Coast Guard, Environmental Protection Agency and Customs and Border Protection Service. CSA sits on the International Chamber of Shipping delegation to the International Maritime Organization in London. CSA is also the U.S. ship owner representative to the International Labor Organization.

Two categories of membership in CSA are available. Full membership is open to any company that has a substantial presence in the U.S. and owns, operates or charters vessels. Associate membership is open to companies who are not qualified for full membership yet have an interest in one or more of the issues address by the organization on behalf of our full members.

HOW IT GOT STARTED!

Captain Jones F. Devlin was the man instrumental in establishing not only the Devlin Awards but also the Safety Achievement Awards. From the time he joined American Export Lines as a Safety at Sea Expert in 1936 until he officially retired in 1967, he devoted his entire professional life to promoting safety of life and property at sea.

In 1954, because of his close association with the American Merchant Marine Institute (AMMI), the predecessor to the Chamber of Shipping, Captain Devlin requested, and the AMMI Board of Directors agreed to sponsor the Safety Achievement Awards. That year, the first Awards were presented to four vessels representing two shipping companies and have continued annually since.

In 1958, Captain Devlin once again approached AMMI's Board regarding sponsorship of an award that would specifically recognize individual ships and their crews for accident-free operations and provide an incentive for safe ship practices. The Board agreed and, in 1959, "Certificate of Honor" awards (renamed the Jones F. Devlin Award in 1960) were presented to 31 vessels representing seven companies and have been presented annually. This is the Sixty-Fourth Anniversary of the program.

SHIP SAFETY ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS

Vessels Receiving Citations of Merit

OVERSEAS LONG BEACH of OSG SHIP MANAGEMENT INC.

We commend the crew of the Overseas Long Beach for their vigilance and bravery on March 30, 2023. 185 nautical miles from shore the watch spotted a small distressed craft and immediately maneuvered to render assistance. Twelve Cuban migrants were rescued whom were at sea for twelve days, including a week without food and little fresh water. Crew members acted as translators and care takers providing medical, food, supplies, and compassion for several days until the survivors disembarked off Key West.

SAVANNAH of CRESCENT TOWING

We commend the crew of the SAVANNAH. Your swift response and heroic actions on March 27, 2023, prevented a maritime safety and environmental catastrophe on the Mississippi River. In the early morning darkness, the powerful river current ripped a large bulker from the pier sending her loaded broadside down the river toward a petro-chemical dock. The Savannah crew immediately sprang into action assisted by none other than Crescent Towing's South Carolina who expertly and calmly navigated charging current, parted mooring lines in the water, darkness, and lack of communication with the bulker to bring the ship under control and to a nearby anchorage. As the sun came up, the Mississippi was open for commerce unaware of the potentially catastrophic incident.

SOUTH CAROLINA of CRESCENT TOWING

We commend the crew of the SOUTH CAROLINA. Your swift response and heroic actions on March 27, 2023, prevented a maritime safety and environmental catastrophe on the Mississippi River. In the early morning darkness, the powerful river current ripped a large bulker from the pier sending her loaded broadside down the river toward a petro-chemical dock. The South Carolina crew immediately sprang into action assisted by none other than Crescent Towing's Savannah who expertly and calmly navigated charging current, parted mooring lines in the water, darkness, and lack of communication with the bulker to bring the ship under control and to a nearby anchorage. As the sun came up, the Mississippi was open for commerce unaware of the potentially catastrophic incident.

SHIP SAFETY ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS

Vessels Receiving Citations of Merit

M/V LISA COOPER of CRESCENT TOWING

We commend the crew of the M/V LISA COOPER. Their swift response and seamanship actions in Mobile Harbor on February 19, 2023, prevented a potential maritime disaster. The experienced crew sprang into action when a ship's lines parted from the pier leaving the ship drifting dead in the water. The Lisa Cooper was first on the scene and maneuvered the drifting ship back to the pier until other tugs and a pilot arrived to re-secure the vessel with lines.

M/V BILL ATKINSON of CANAL BARGE COMPANY, INC.

We commend the crew of the M/V BILL ATKINSON. Their alert response and articulate actions on July 31, 2022, saved the life of a distressed survivor in the Cumberland River. The expertly trained crew maneuvered and retrieved the survivor with the skiff then provided critical physical and emotional support to the survivor until emergency responders arrived.

SAVANNAH of CRESCENT TOWING

We commend the crew of the SAVANNAH for their astute watch and brave actions on the Mississippi River July 9, 2022. The Captain spotted a survivor clinging to a piece of driftwood being pulled down the river. The Savannah's crew diligently maneuvered to the distressed and disoriented survivor safely pulling him onboard and caring for him until emergency responders arrived.
